

Errata: *Hats to Knit*

(Changes highlighted in **bold**)

Attention Cap: page 43

Text should read:

To start the brim, cast on **46** stitches loosely using US 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles:

Row 1: *k1, p1*, repeat from *to* to the end of the row

Row 2: * k1b, p1*, repeat from *to* to the end of the row

Repeat row 2 until your work measures 2¾ in (7 cm) from the cast-on edge. Do not turn.

Change to a US 7 (4.5 mm) circular needle or double-pointed needles and cast on **26** stitches loosely for the hat body (72 stitches)

Mother Earth Beret: page 61

Text should read:

Cast on **48** (54, 60) stitches loosely using US 11 (8 mm) double-pointed needles

. . .

Start increasing for body of hat and change pattern:

Round 3 (increase): ***k7** (k5, k5), kfb*, repeat from *to* to the end of the round (54, 63, 70 stitches)

. . .

Round 9: *k1, p1*, repeat from *to* to the end of the round

Round 10: as round **9**

Round 11: as round **9**

City Cable: pages 79 & 80

Text should read:

Row 17 (cable row): k2, p2, *sl2 onto cable needle, hold at front, k2, p2 from left-hand needle, k2 from cable needle, p2*, repeat from *to* to the last stitch, k1

Repeat rows 2–17 until your work measures the right length for your head circumference, allowing for a 1 in (2.5 cm) overlap, or follow the instructions for the different sizes.

SMALL SIZE:

Repeat rows 2–17 until your work measures approximately 20¾ in (53 cm) from the cast-on edge.

MEDIUM SIZE:

Repeat rows 2–17 until your work measures approximately 22¾ in (57.5 cm) from the cast-on edge.

LARGE SIZE:

Repeat rows 2–17 until your work measures approximately 24 in (61 cm) from the cast-on edge.

EXTRA LARGE SIZE:

Repeat rows 2–17 until your work measures approximately 25 in (63.5 cm) from the cast-on edge.
